## FALL FEDERATION WEEKEND PRESENTATIONS

Speakers at the Saturday morning meeting included System Chancellor John Sharp '72, VP for Enrollment & Academic Services Joseph P. Pettibon II, and Student Body President Mikey Jaillet '20.

### **Highlights**

- In 2018-2019, Aggie Moms' Clubs donated over \$700,000 to the University for scholarships and organizations.
- Enrollment has now passed that of University of Central Florida, making TAMU the largest university in the U.S. with 64,000 students on the main campus, 52,000 of which are undergrads.
- The "academic admit" category (top 25% with SAT >1360) will be eliminated as of fall 2021 applications.
- Freshmen are strongly encouraged to attend career fairs in order to become comfortable interacting with employers. First up is Engineering, September 4-5.

- <u>Hullabaloo U</u> is a new first year experience course. It's a pilot program this year, but may be mandatory next year.
- The current student body president is advocating for more healthy food options on campus.
- Current Federation President Cathleen Inman has selected the <u>Veteran Resource Support</u> <u>Center</u> as the TAMU department to be highlighted during her term. TAMU is only university in the country with 2 full-time staffers dedicated to military admissions advising.
- TAMU and U.S. Army will build new combat development complex at the RELLIS campus in Bryan. It will be used to develop and test nextgeneration technologies.
