April has us zooming through online conversations, and while it is not as good as a hug with all of you, come join us in the Zoom online meetings. We continue to be thankful for all of the times we were together throughout this year, and now we look forward to talking with and supporting each other and our students, whether at home or on campus.

Thanks to your help with fundraising this year, we set aside \$6,000 for the 100th Anniversary Endowed Scholarship fund, which will take the account to \$22,000 of the \$25,000 needed to fully fund the scholarship. Another portion of our fundraising profits are dedicated to \$5,000 in annual scholarships that we award to a student from each class and to a corps member, all chosen by the TAMU Scholarship and Financial Aid Department, and \$500 for the Corps Leadership Award.

Currently, we are collecting members' votes for the student organizations that will receive the remaining available funds from our Dallas County Aggie Moms' Club. Tell us how you'd like your share to be distributed via this <u>online</u> form by May 15th.

I hope everyone will join us on Zoom for the Annual Meeting on April 23rd where we'll elect officers for 2020-21 and connect virtually with other Aggie Moms as we share stories of our Aggies. It has been a joy to talk with some of you already about our Aggie students who are facing changes to their routines and summer plans but staying strong. Please attend the meeting to share those encouraging and sometimes entertaining stories, such as taking online upper level summer courses instead of working at internships or taking over the cooking at home.
